## Publication Rules for Certificates, etc.

- 1. The test items and test results should be described correctly. In addition, any units and notes (test conditions, etc.) should be included with the test results.
- 2. The Client should refrain from omitting unfavourable results (ex. results that differ from the standard values) in the certificate or report.
- 3. If the Client wishes to mention that the test results were reported by JFRL, the Client should print the information listed below with the test results.

Test trustee: Japan Food Research Laboratories

Issued date of certificate/report: Day Month Year

The address and telephone number, etc. of JFRL should not be included.

If the Client converts the test results into values per one serving size, etc., the Client must be responsible for ensuring the correct conversion and should mention that the converted values have been calculated by the Client.

- 4. Certificate or reports themselves should not be printed on publishing materials that are produced by the Client.
- 5. Any descriptions must not contain misleading language such as that suggesting that JFRL certifies the Client's products.
- 6. The Client shall be responsible for published materials that are produced by the Client.
- 7. JFRL will not mediate or become involved in any disputes or problems regarding published materials that are produced by the Client.
